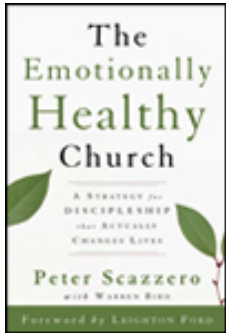


SCAZZERO CLERGY FORUM

Peter Scazzero is author of *The Emotionally Healthy Church* (Zondervan, 2003), winner of the Gold Medallion Award for 2003. He is the founder and senior pastor of New Life Fellowship Church in Queens, New York City, a large, multiracial, international church with over fifty-five countries represented. Out of his successes and failures of pastoring, he, along with his wife Geri, embarked on a journey of integrating emotional health and spirituality.

A graduate from Gordon-Conwell (M.Div.) and Eastern Baptist Theological Seminary (D. Min. in marriage and family), Peter has authored several best selling Bible study guides including *Love: The Key to Building Healthy Relationships*, *New Life in Christ*, *Christian Character* and *Christian Disciplines*.

This past year, Peter, along with his wife Geri, founded the Center for Emotional Health and Spirituality, applying emotional health to biblical spirituality in order to transform leaders, marriages, churches, organizations and multicultural reconciliation initiatives. They regularly speak to pastors and leaders around North America on implementing the principles of *The Emotionally Healthy Church* in their churches and ministries.
